### **PACKET PICK-UP:**

Follow these steps to pick up your number:

1. Confirm your entry for the 2019 Carlsbad 5000 by [clicking here](#).
2. Bring your photo ID. Youth runners without ID, show registration confirmation.
3. Pick up your bib w/ timing tag and race shirt.

You may pick up for others and/or others may pick up for you! A copy of the participant's photo ID is required – either printed or a photo on a phone.

### **RACE BIBS:**

Your race bib features a disposable RFID tag attached to the back. Please follow these instructions to receive an accurate time:

1. Wear your bib & ensure it is visible on the front of your torso.
2. Don't fold or wrinkle your bib to avoid damaging the timing chip.
3. Pin your bib on using safety pins on all four corners so the timing chip stays flat.
4. Don't cover your bib with jackets, bags, etc., so as not to block the timing chip.

Bib transfer are not permitted. If somebody other than yourself uses your bib, you and the party running with your bib will both be disqualified from the event.

### **2019 REGISTRATION:**

Online registration ends Friday, April 5 at 11:59P PT. On-site registration will be available Saturday and Sunday, until the event is sold out.

- 5K: \$45
- ALL DAY 20K: \$85

**Credit and debit payments only. No cash or checks will be accepted for payment on-site.**

## **PARKING:**

Various public parking lots and street parking are available throughout the Village of Carlsbad. We encourage participants to carpool and use the Tamarack, Las Flores, Carlsbad Village and Vista Way (Highway 78) exits. Most participants driving into the Village of Carlsbad will need to find available street parking in the surrounding area of the start/finish lines. Please note, we recommend arriving at least 1 HOUR prior to your race to allow time to find parking and warm up.

## DIRECTIONS

Take I-5 and exit west on Tamarack, Las Flores, Carlsbad Village Dr., or Vista Way (Highway 78) exits.

- TO THE EXPO ON SATURDAY OR SUNDAY – Roosevelt St. (between Grand Ave. & Carlsbad Village Drive)
- TO THE START LINE ON SUNDAY – Near Harding St. & Grand Ave. Please enter the start line from Harding St.

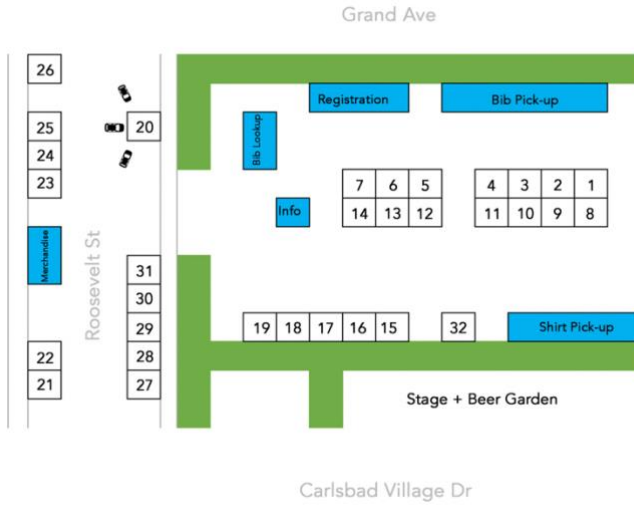

## RACE SPECIFICS

### **RACE ASSIGNMENTS & AGE GROUP AWARDS:**

During registration, you selected the race you intend to run. Your bib is assigned based on the race you selected. Please note, participants *must run in the race that matches their age and sex* in order to be eligible for Age Group awards. If you are assigned to a different race but would like to be eligible for Age Group awards (top 3 finishers by age divisions), please visit the Solutions tent after you pick up your bib in order to be reassigned.

### **START LINE:**

Participants should line up based on estimated pace per mile (“FAST” 6-7min/mile | “FIT” 8-11min/mile | “FUN” 12-15min/mile). When the horn blows, all runners will be released at once for each race start. There are no ‘corrals’ at the start line. For the safety of all event participants, if you plan to walk please seed yourself towards the back.

**PLEASE NOTE:** All participants must wear their race bib with the tag intact in order to have their times recorded. No bib = no time! Please make sure the race bib is pinned at torso height at the front and is visible throughout the race.

### **RAILROAD SAFETY INFORMATION:** \*BE CAREFUL WHEN CROSSING THE TRACKS\*

Please remember to only cross railroad tracks at a designated pedestrian or roadway crossing. Observe and obey all warning signs and signals. NEVER walk down a train track – it is illegal and very dangerous.

**Please take note that the trains traveling through Carlsbad do not follow exact set schedules and may arrive at any time – including during all races.**



**NOTE:** The course crosses two sets of railroad tracks. The train schedule is **NEVER** final and can be altered at any point. Carlsbad 5000 and Junior Carlsbad 5000 races can be stopped, delayed, and are subject to change at any time (including race day) for the safety of all event participants. Please follow the guidance of event and city officials in the event that a train passes during your race. **Safety first!**

### **RESTROOMS:**

Portable toilets will be located near the start and finish lines.

### **COURSE SUPPORT:**

There is one aid station at approximately Mile 1.5 on course. It will provide WATER ONLY. If you feel you will need additional electrolytes or nutrition during your race, please plan accordingly.

### **MEDICAL INFORMATION:**

Kaiser Permanente is supporting the event with the official Medical Director and AMR and the Carlsbad Fire department, and this team is a dedicated group of medical professionals available to help you. Medical Stations will be located at the Start and at the Finish.

### **TOP 250 FINISHERS:**

The first 250 finishers in each age group race (*4 total*) will receive a finisher medal with a special TOP 250 ribbon. Top 250 finishers for each age group race are determined by gun time, NOT chip time. **Top 250 medals are race specific and awarded to eligible participants only. For example, a man running in the Masters Women race would not receive a medal.**

### **AWARDS:**

Age group awards will be presented to the top 3 finishers in female and male categories for the 5K distance. Runners must run in their Age/Gender Division race to earn an award in your category. (*e.g., Male 27 years old is only eligible for awards in the Men 39 & Under race // Woman 53 years old is only eligible for awards in the Masters Women (40+) race*). In accordance with USATF Rules, age group awards will be determined by chip time. To be timed and eligible for age group awards you must wear your timing chip on your bib and you **MUST** run your appropriate age group race (*see 2019 Schedule on Page 1*). Elite and Masters are based on gun time.

**AGE GROUP AWARDS MUST BE PICKED UP AT THE AWARDS TENT. Awards will not be mailed after the event.**

The Carlsbad 5000 is organized and directed under [USA Track & Field \("USATF"\)](#) rules and regulations.

Wristbands will be provided to participants for beer redemption. **YOU MUST SHOW YOUR BIB AND PHOTO ID IN ORDER TO RECEIVE A WRISTBAND, no exceptions.** Wristbands will be marked for two beer redemptions.

**DRUG TESTING:** The event will engage the United States Anti-Doping Agency (USADA), in accordance with the International Standards of Doping Control, to test selected athletes who earn prize money. Athletes who participate in the Carlsbad 5000 may be subject to drug testing in accordance with the United States Anti-Doping Agency (USADA) Protocol for Olympic Movement Testing (USADA Protocol). USADA will be responsible for conducting comprehensive drug testing, as well as the adjudication of positive findings. Athletes with positive drug test results will have their cases adjudicated according to the USADA Protocol and will be penalized, if appropriate, according to applicable IAAF or World Anti-Doping Agency rules. Such penalties may include, but not be limited to, a period of ineligibility from competition, as well as disqualification from past competitions and cancellation of awards and prizes previously awarded. Any substance taken by an athlete is at his/her own risk and may result in a positive sample. **BEWARE:** Some nutritional supplements, prescription, cold medicines and over-the-counter medications contain prohibited substances.
