



The new course has the same elevation change as the old course, but with 3 fewer turns... **Get ready to shave time off your Carlsbad 5000 PR!**

TURNAROUND: Tamarack Volleyball Courts
FINISH: Carlsbad Village Dr & Carlsbad Blvd
